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There are three counts for each year on the report. Each year has a count and a percent composition for each population category.

For the category of the population who are age 55-64, there were 4,944 people in the Census year living in the trade area of Troy. That made up 9.86% of the total population of the trade area in the Census year.

In the current year, there are 5,337 people living in the trade area of Troy, between the ages of 55-64. That makes up 10.64% of the trade area.

Five years from now there are projected to be 5,277 people living in the trade area of Troy, between the ages of 55-64. That will make up 10.42% of the population.
