SOCIAL VULNERABILITY INDEX*

Here, the average Social Vulnerability Index for the Trade Area (Richmond Hill) is **79**. This value is benchmarked to the province of Ontario.

Key social indicators suggest a **below-average** vulnerability for the households in the Trade Area (Richmond Hill) when compared to the households in the benchmark (Ontario).

For each of the variables, there is a percentage and/or Index value that correlates to the population or households within the Trade Area (Richmond Hill).

Here, **32.7%** of households in the Trade Area (Richmond Hill) reported that they have close friends in the same city (at least one or two friends).

Households in the Trade Area (Richmond Hill) are 14% (Index of **114**) more likely to have close friends in the same city when compared to households in the benchmark (Ontario).
