

Executive Dashboards - NewToCanada - Trade Area

Captures Canadian immigration trends by country and region of origin, quantifying permanent and non-permanent residents in a specified Trade Area.

Permanent resident: Someone who has been given permanent resident status by immigrating to Canada, but is not a Canadian citizen.

Temporary resident: Someone who is in Canada temporarily, like a student or foreign worker.

In this example, for the city of Kingston, Ontario, and for the most recent rolling twelve-month period, 248 people were classified as permanent residents of Canada who originated from India. This made up 22.86% of the total permanent residents by country of citizenship for the same time period. In comparison, 220 people were classified as permanent residents of Canada from India, which is 22.96% of the total permanent residents by country of citizenship, for the earlier reported time period. The difference in the counts of permanent residents from India between these two time periods is 28 people, which accounts for an increase of 12.7%.

Data is presented by **Country of Citizenship** and **Region of Citizenship**, representing the country and region of origin for new residents.

21Q2 to 22Q1: Most recent twelve-month period. Note that this field is updated quarterly.

21Q1 to 21Q4: Earlier twelve-month period to provide trend analysis. Note that this field is updated quarterly.

Count: Refers to the flow of incoming permanent or temporary residents in the specified time period.

% (Total Permanent Resident by Country of Citizenship, Total Permanent Resident by Region of Citizenship): The proportion of the total household population. Note that the total household population data is not displayed in this report.

% (Country of Citizenship, Region of Citizenship): The proportion of Total Permanent Resident by Country of Citizenship or Total Permanent Resident by Region of Citizenship.

Absolute Change: The difference in counts between the most recent and earlier reported time periods.

% Change: The difference in the count of new residents between the two time periods reported as a percentage. Red cells indicate a positive change while blue cells a negative change.
